### June

#### Writing with Ease

**(2 Week Course offered in June) Rate: \$385.00**

Writing is not a skill you were either born with or not; you can learn the necessary skills to engage your readers. In just a few weeks you will gain confidence as a writer and never again will you give up before starting to write. The Writing with Ease workshop covers the following topics: idea generation, leads, conclusions, transitions, conventions, grammar rules, essay writing and directives, proofreading, research and literary analysis. With small student to teacher ratios, this course is ideal for that student who benefits from consistent one-on-one feedback.
